Parent/Teacher Quick-Start Guide

Assignment Grading

85-95% of your student's work is graded automatically by the Ignitia program. Some assignments, such as essays and short answers, must be graded by you as the parent/teacher.

Assignment Alerts

Select the Assignment Alerts tab to see a list of assignments that need teacher grading, overdue assignments, assignments that need to be reassigned, and assignments that are blocked for not achieving a passing score. At the top of this page, there is a drop-down menu that allows you to see your student's progress over the previous seven days. Click on a specific assignment title (underlined) to go directly to that assignment.

Assignment Alerts in Gradebook

Select *Gradebook* > *Action Required* to see all student help requests and a list of assignments that need teacher grading. The **Type** column indicates what type of attention each assignment needs (e.g. grading, reassigning, etc.). Click on an assignment title (bold print) to go to that assignment and complete the necessary action.

Gradebook

Gradebook shows your student's progress. Select the *Gradebook* tab, enter your student's name in the **Student** bar, and click **Search**.

- Click on the + next to each course to see the lessons in that course.
- Click on the + next to each lesson to see the progress in that specific lesson.
